Principles:


Energy is an integral part of climate action and its management, therefore, the policy intends to achieve this through some of the identified initiatives but not restricted to the below mentioned:

- Setting realistic objectives and targets for continual improvement of energy performance and energy management system and regularly monitoring progress and reviewing performance.
- Conducting energy audits at regular intervals to identify energy-saving opportunities and areas of improvement. The results of these audits should be used to create a comprehensive energy management plan.
